1. Sarah and Christian planted pumpkins last summer. In October, Sarah picked 5 pumpkins, Christian picked 3. How many pumpkins do they have?
2. Hugh cooked 9 ears of corn. Sadie ate 2. How many ears are left?
3. Farmer Don picked a pumpkin that was 4 pounds, Farmer Theresa picked one that was 6 pounds. Whose pumpkin was bigger?
4. Lincoln had 8 apples in a bag. 3 apples had worms in them. How many apples are still good to eat?
5. Caramel Apples cost \$1 each at the Farmer's Market. How much does it cost to buy 4 caramel apples?
6. One corn stalk has 3 ears growing on it. The other stalk has 4 ears. How many ears in all?
